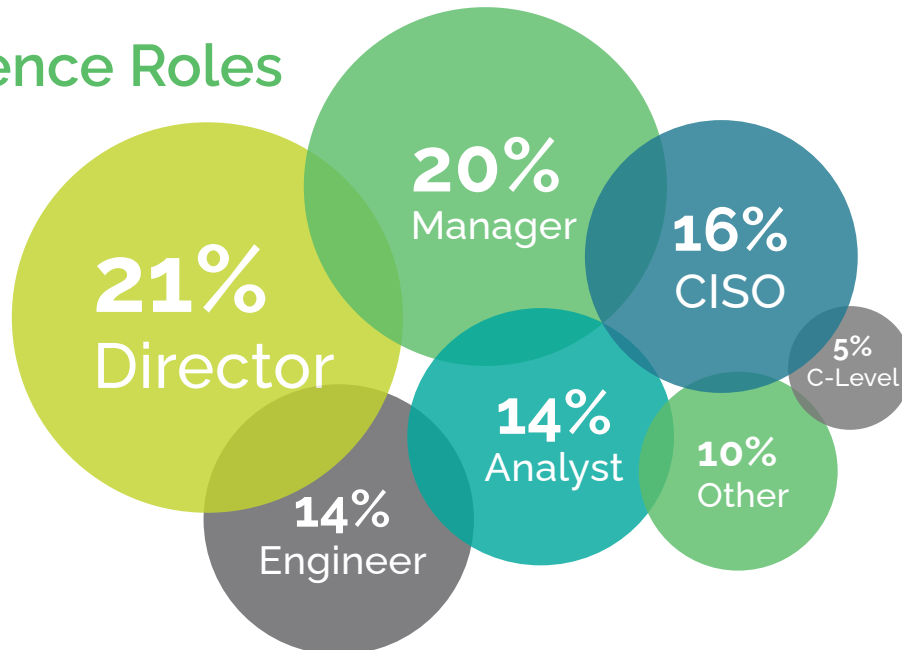

New Faces of the RH-ISAC – Goals, Priorities, & Creating a Culture of Information Sharing

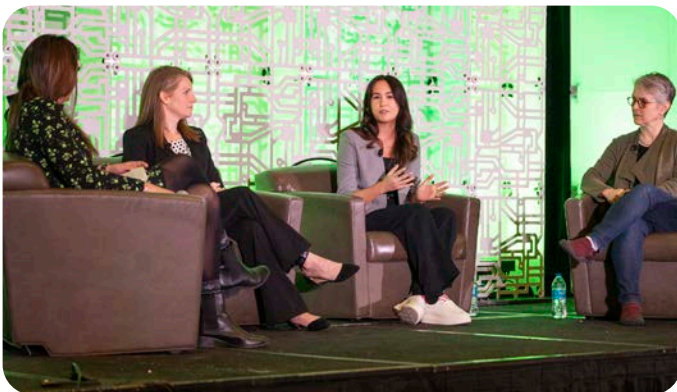
